- Can I use public keys with SSH?

# Frequently Asked Questions

- I have a new machine, now what?
  - We can install it with the standard setup for your group
  - You can install it and maintain it yourself (subject to some guidelines)
- I brought in the workstation I built, help me put it on AFS
  - Not so fast, we'll want to take a look
- VPN is bad, mmkay, give me a public IP!
  - Sure, are you MinSec or ResSec compliant?
  - ResSec: logging to remote server, firewall, emergency access
- Can you install software X for me?
  - Maybe. What's the project's URL?
- What information do I need to provide when I have a problem?
  - Who, What, Where, Unique
